

ARHA High Point+ Rules

Program Rules

- 1. The Top Ten (10) ARHA enrolled horses will be awarded.
- 2. The annual qualifying period is January 1st through December 31st.
- 3. Completed annual enrollment form must be submitted with \$75.00 enrollment fee prior to competition.
- 4. Point results will be based on the placings of the horse only. Multiple exhibitors will be permitted.
- You are responsible for submitting official class results to ARHA home office for recording within 15 business days from end of show.
- 6. Points participation form must accompany official show results.

Horse and Exhibitor Eligibility

- 1. Horse must be registered with the American Roan Horse Association.
- 2. All owners and exhibitors must be current ARHA members prior to competition. ARHA membership is based on a calendar year of Jan 1st to Dec 31st.

Point Schedule

- 1. 1st through 10th place will be awarded per Point Schedule chart above.
- 2. Any ARHA horse in the official class placing, beyond 10th place will receive ½ point.
