



World Championship Show All-Around Award Guidelines



SHW803: All-Around Champion: To be eligible for all-around champion award, a horse may show in one or any of the following divisions: Open, Amateur, or Youth division **AND** must compete in at least three or more categories listed below:

Category I: Halter/Performance Halter

Category II: Ranch Riding
Ranch Trail
Trail

Category III: Hunter Under Saddle
Ranch Rail
Western Pleasure

Category IV: Hunt Seat Equitation
Showmanship at halter
Western Horsemanship

The winner of the all-around award is determined by adding points earned by each horse in the open division, amateur, and youth in every class in which it placed in the top nine. The horse in the open division, amateur, and youth, must have competed in at least three of the approved events in three or more categories and earning the greatest number of points shall be awarded the all-around win.

Scoring: Horses competing in performance in the open, amateur, youth divisions and placing in the top nine, will be given one credit for each horse or contestant placing below them, plus one credit not to exceed nine credits for first place.

-EXAMPLE: In a class of nine or more horses, the first place horse receives nine credits, second place eight credits, and so on through ninth place. No credits are to be awarded to a disqualified horse or contestant regardless of the number in the class. However, when less than nine are placed, even though more than nine entered the class, credits will be awarded based on the number of exhibited in the class.

Ties: The horse in the amateur, open, or youth, will be declared the all-around which earned credits in the greatest number of events:

1. The horse or contestant winning over the greatest number of horses
2. Earned the most credits in performance events
